Contract Fact

Article XIV.G.3. Per Diem Pay For Summer Work

A teacher who works approved extra duty days after the end of the school year, but before his/her first (1st) work day of the following school year, shall be paid at his/her per diem rate in effect at the end of that school year. Thereafter, a teacher who works approved extra duty days shall be paid for those days at his/her then current per diem rate.
