The theme for this year's Summit is We Can't Wait. The mission of this event is to dismantle the cradle to prison pipeline for children of color and children in poverty through education. High school and undergraduate students, parents, education professionals, child welfare and juvenile justice professionals are invited to attend.

The Summit is free to students and parents and \$35 for professionals. Graduate credit (.5) through Adams State is available for an additional \$27.50.

75% of registration fees will be returned to youth as scholarships and educational gifts for post-secondary education. To date in excess of \$120,000 in scholarships and over 120 laptops have been given away.
